- Selections will be made by the committee on or before August 18, 2014.
- Recipients will be notified by August 31, 2014 of the selection. Arrangements for forwarding the Scholarship to the recipient will be made at that time.
- Recipients must enroll at an Accredited Institution of higher learning within 6 months of being awarded the scholarship or money must be returned to the Eastern Section of IAEI.
